MiChild

- Program for low income working families with children who are under age 19
- Services include, health care, vision, dental, and mental health services
- Pay just \$10 a month for your whole family (even if you have more than one child)
- *Eligibility:*
 - Be under age 19, Have no other health insurance, Have a Social Security Number, Live in Michigan, Be U.S. citizen or qualified immigrant, and Meet income limits

Healthy Kids

- Provides a wide range of health care coverage and support services for qualifying pregnant women, babies and children under age 19
- *Eligibility:*
 - Be under age 19, or pregnant, Have a Social Security Number, Live in Michigan, even for a short time, Be U.S. citizen or qualified immigrant, and Meet income limits

Care for Flint (Medicaid Waiver)

- If you already receive Medicaid, this expansion comes with new services
- *Eligibility:*
 - Anyone under 21 or pregnant woman, Meet income limits, and was served by the Flint water system from April 2014 until now

Healthy Michigan Plan

- Encourages healthy behaviors, personal responsibility, and helps low-income resident’s access affordable health coverage
- *Eligibility:*
 - Between the ages of 19-64 years old, Meet income limits, Do not qualify for or are not enrolled in Medicare or other Medicaid programs, Are not pregnant at the time of application, and Are residents of the State of Michigan
