Blue Cross Complete, Meridian, Molina, or Midwest Medicaid

Bluecaid Cab: 1-888-803-4947 – Call 2 business days in advance. Meridian Cab: 1-800-821-9369 – Call 3 business days in advance. Molina Cab: 1-888-898-7969 – Call 3 business days in advance. Midwest Cab: 1-888-654-2200 – Call 4 business days in advance.

*Transportation to medical and mental health appointments is a covered benefit for patients who have Blue Cross Complete, Meridian, Midwest, or Molina Medicaid insurance plans.

The following information must be provided when requesting transportation services:

- Their name, date of birth, and Medicaid number.
- Their current address (must match what Medicaid has on file)
- Appointment time
- Clinic name and address (the clinic must be in-network with insurance)
- Any special needs (car seat, wheelchair)

NOTE: Straight Medicaid does not provide transportation

Fare Deal Card (½ fare on individual rides or monthly bus cards)

*Must be 60-64 years of age or low income (prove with Medicaid or Medicare ID card, or referral from DHS) *Must present a valid (unexpired) state ID or driver's license to qualify.

*Seniors (65 and older) ride the bus for free by qualifying for a Senior Card.

Door-to-door (A-Ride) service

- * Offered to those with disabilities. A \$3 fee per way applies and reservations must be made in advance.
- *To qualify you must fill out a 13 page application.

Students

- * Ride for ½ fare with school ID (high school or middle school).
- *Children under 5 ride free.
