- a. All shelters and long-term supportive housing in Washtenaw County is filled by Housing Access
- b. They assist low-income individuals/families who are:
  - i. Facing eviction
  - ii. Who owe back rent
  - iii. Who are experiencing homelessness
  - iv. With no ongoing place to stay
  - v. Need assistance with security deposits/moving costs
- 2. Stay on the line or leave a message with a number where you can be reached. A HAWC representative will call you back within 24 hours.
- 3. Eligibility will be determined, referrals and education will be given, and assistance will be provided, if eligible.
