- Call for appointment; Mon 9am-1pm, Tues 9am-8pm, Wed 10am-5pm, Thurs 9am-12:30pm, Fri 9am-2pm
- Eligibility requirements:
 - Must be 18-65 years of age
 - Must be within income guidelines
 - Must bring proof of income, social security card and current state ID
- Services offered: Intake, triage, physician's consultations, referrals to specialists, & tests
- There is no charge for services, including specialty care and tests by referral
- Has an on-site pharmacy. Prescribed medications are provided at no charge (no controlled meds)
- Staff available to assist with insurance enrollment
