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ELIGIBILITY*

You must live in Michigan and be a US citizen or qualified immigrant to be eligible for these plans.

Healthy Michigan Plan

- Ages 19-64
- Income below 133% of Federal Poverty Level (FPL)
- Have a social security number or proof of immigrant status

MiChild

- Ages 18 and under
- Meet income requirements
- Have a social security number (or have applied for one)
- · Have no other health insurance
- \$10/family monthly premium that covers all children in the home

Healthy Kids

- Under age 19
 OR
 Pregnant and between 160-195% FPL
- Have a social security number (or have applied for one)

HOW TO APPLY

- 2. Create user name and password
- 3. Apply for benefits including emergency relief
- 4. Check application status
- 5. Check benefit status
- 6. Complete recertification
