Healthy Michigan Plan

- For ages 19 - 64
- Income below 138% of Federal Poverty level
- Have a social security number or have applied for one
- Have no comprehensive health insurance, including Medicaid or Medicare
- Live in Michigan
- US citizen or qualified immigrant

Healthy Kids

- For ages 18 and under
- Income below 160% of Federal Poverty level
- Have a social security number
- Live in Michigan
- US citizen or qualified immigrant

Find out if your family is eligible for insurance through the State of Michigan.

Healthy Michigan Plan

1. Go to www.mibridges.michigan.gov
2. Create a user name and password
3. Apply for benefits, including emergency relief
4. Check application status
5. Check benefit status
6. Complete recertification

Health Insurance Marketplace

1. Go to www.healthcare.gov
2. Create a marketplace account
3. Select health insurance

What You Need to Apply

- Name, Date of Birth, and Social Security Number for everyone in your household
- Current household income
- Household size
- If you are not a US citizen, you will need immigration information
- Policy numbers for any current health insurance plans covering members in your household
