ELIGIBILITY*

You must live in Michigan and be a US citizen or qualified immigrant to be eligible for these plans.

Healthy Michigan Plan

- Ages 19-64
- Income below 133% of Federal Poverty Level (FPL)
- Have a social security number or proof of immigrant status

MiChild

- Ages 18 and under
- Meet income requirements
- Have a social security number (or have applied for one)
- Have no other health insurance
- \$10/family monthly premium that covers all children in the home

* Eligibility is expanded in the Flint area

Healthy Kids

- Under age 19
OR
Pregnant and between 160-195% FPL
- Have a social security number (or have applied for one)

HOW TO APPLY

1. Go to www.mibridges.michigan.gov
2. Create user name and password
3. Apply for benefits including emergency relief
4. Check application status
5. Check benefit status
6. Complete recertification

WHAT YOU NEED TO APPLY

- Name, date of birth, and social security number for everyone in your household
- If you are not a US citizen or national, you will need information confirming your immigration status
- Current household income
- Household size
- Policy numbers for any current health insurance plans covering members in your household

All information will be verified through the Department of Human Services
