- Services are offered twice a school year, typically in October/November, and in April/May
- Parents may sign up their students by completing a Mobile Dentist form at their RAHS Health Center
- All RAHS patients are eligible for services every 6 months
- As with all RAHS services, we accept both insured and uninsured patients with no out-of-pocket charges

- A \$5 donation per visit is requested, but not required

- Patients must be 18 years of age or older
- Following treatments are available at low cost
 - Sealant, Fluoride treatment, Cleaning and oral exam, X-rays, and Fillings
