- Eligibility and benefits based on household income
- Apply in person at local DHHS office or online
- Office hours vary by location; online application

- If you have a Bridge Card, you can use this program
- Certain purchases of milk or fresh, frozen, dried, or canned fruits and vegetables with your Bridge Card earns Food Bucks
- Can earn up to \$20 in Double Up credits daily
- Sign-up at participating sites
 - State ID and Bridge Card required to sign up
