The Regional Alliance for Healthy Schools (RAHS) has been serving the community for 25 years. RAHS' 17 school-based health centers and mental health hubs in Genesee and Washtenaw Counties, including the RAHS mobile unit, serve as a safety net providing fully comprehensive physical and mental health services to youth 0-21, regardless of where they attend school or their ability to pay. Also, RAHS provides ancillary vision and dental services, in addition to expanding to on-site physical and sports therapy services. RAHS staff identify gaps in care and assist families with addressing social determinants of health by providing a variety of resources to vulnerable and underserved communities.
