Grab and Go

For summer 2025, the Michigan Department of Education has approved SFSP sites in rural areas to provide Non-Congregate meals, which means families can take the food home to eat. Each site (listed below) will distribute seven free breakfasts and seven free lunches, once per week for each child, serving children 18 and under only.

Additionally, individuals up to age 26, enrolled in a state-recognized education program, are also eligible. Children do not have to be present to receive meals. Proxy pickup allowed (picking up for other children).
